



With the increased concern of the Coronavirus pandemic, North Canyon Medical Center has implemented additional precautions. These precautionary measures have been put in place to keep our patients and staff safe. We appreciate your understanding as we all navigate these changing times.

Inpatient Visitor Restrictions - Effective 3/18

- Visiting hours are now restricted to 10:00am - 5:00pm.
- Patients will be restricted to one visitor per day.
- Patients in isolation or positive for Coronavirus will not be allowed visitors.
- No visitors under the age of 18.
- All visitors will be screened

Screening to enter NCMC - Effective 3/18

Access into NCMC will be restricted to three entry points, all other entry points will be closed. This applies to patients, visitors, vendors, staff & providers.

Access to NCMC will be available through the following locations:

- Main Hospital Entrance
- Medical Plaza Entrance
- Emergency Department

Upon entering, everyone will follow the same check-in process to log everyone who enters, why they are here and to be screened for a fever.

Elective Surgeries – Effective 3/18

At the recommendation of the U.S. Surgeon General, to cancel elective surgeries during the COVID-19 pandemic, we are postponing all elective surgeries March 18th -31st. At that time, an assessment of the COVID-19 pandemic will determine if we are able to reopen our surgery schedule.
